# Special Meeting Minutes Pikeville Town Hall 6:00 pm, Thursday, May 30, 2024

## **Agenda Adoption:**

## **Budget Discussion**

Commissioner Thomas presented the 2024 budget. The initial draft budget has already been filed with the state and the final will be presented at the monthly board meeting Monday, June 10, 2024. The town has over 100K in general fund savings above the state recommended guidelines. Long term and one-time expenses were reviewed. The police budget will have a minimal increase of \$324.00 for fiscal year 24/25 and funds will be set aside for future vehicle purchases.

### **Public Comments:**

Kellie West – 115 Collingwood Drive, Pikeville

Mrs. West questioned whether part-time employees would be included if the board approved Christmas bonuses. She feels a \$500 bonus and Christmas party is too much for the town to fund. She stated the personnel policy and job descriptions had previously been updated but not followed and the board needs to take into consideration benefits paid by the town.

Mary Bailey- 419 N Washington St., Pikeville

Inquired on town ordinances which are expected to be completed this fall.

She feels spending 10k for fireworks is too much for one event and feels the board made a quick decision and should reconsider funding next year.

Lyman Galloway – 303 W Main St, Pikeville Mr. Galloway does not agree with the idea of giving town employees Christmas bonuses.

The board needs to make it clear that grant money is being used for town projects. If the Town of Pikeville does not spend grant money received it will be given to other surrounding towns.
